



300 Club Member Pool Party Rules

300 Club members must schedule pool parties with the Aquatic Director. Parties scheduled during normal pool hours may not require an extra guard. Please remember that during normal pool hours other members will also be using the pool. Additional costs will be incurred if after hour parties are scheduled.

Contact the Aquatic Director (the300ClubSwim@cfcxmail.com) and include the following information:

- Your name and contact information.
- Preferred date and time period.
- Number of participants.
- Ages and number of children.
- Type of party.
- Special requests.

The following rules will apply:

- Parties with more than 10 children will require a second guard on duty. Cost will be \$10/hour. A second guard may also be required at the discretion of the Aquatic Director.
- For parties scheduled on the weekends during normal pool hours, there will be a limit of 30 participants. Exceptions may be requested through the Aquatic Director.
- Members having a party can request a second guard for less than 10 children.
- Members will be billed a guard charge (if applicable) and \$2/non-member children and \$5 per non-member adult. (Non-members that do not swim will not be charged.)
- Members must sign-in all their guests with full names. Please ask the guard on duty for sign-in sheet.
- No food or drinks are allowed on the lower pool deck or in the pool.
- Food and drinks are allowed on the upper deck by the picnic tables.
- Absolutely no glass containers, gum or smoking are allowed in the entire pool area including the bathrooms.
- Pets are not allowed.
- Children in diapers must wear a swim diaper or plastic pants that are tight around the waist and legs.
- Under no circumstances are children or adults with diarrhea allowed in the water.
- Under no circumstances are diapers or swimsuits to be changed on the pool deck.
- Pool toys, such as squirt guns etc., may be used at the discretion of the lifeguards on duty.
